- Class can focus on a project from 3 Quote Quilts pattern or coaching students to make their own design.

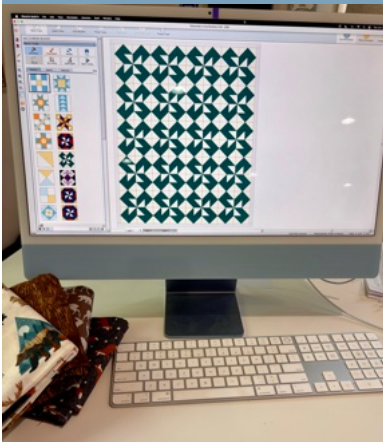
Recommended Class Size:

Cricut Design Space - Learn how to use a die cutting machine to cut fabric, appliqué pieces and motifs, and quilt blocks.

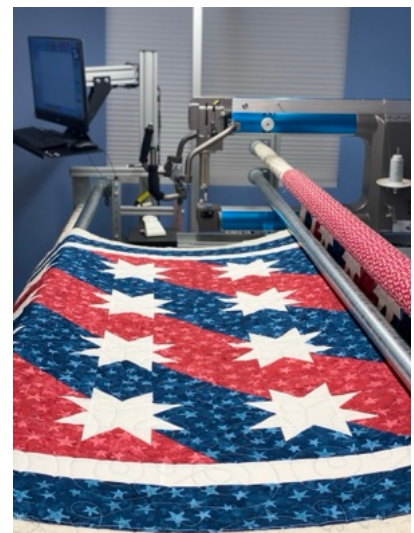
